MINUTES OF NEC MEETING

An online meeting of the National Executive Committee of AICAOA held on 12<sup>th</sup>Apr.' 2026at 3:00 PM on Google Meet. Agenda-wise deliberations/decisions of NEC are as below:

**Agenda 1: Submissions of comments on questionnaire issued by 8<sup>th</sup> CPC:**

**Deliberations:** Shri U C Joshi, Chairman, 8<sup>th</sup> CPC Committee informed all members that comments of AICAOA on questionnaire of 8<sup>th</sup> CPC has already been deliberated in 8<sup>th</sup> CPC Committee's meeting on 11.04.2026. Draft is in its final stage and will be shared before NEC soon for consideration of NEC, AICAOA. He further informed that last date for submission of comments is 30<sup>th</sup> Apr.'2026.

**Agenda 2: Complaint regarding physical, mental and emotional harassment of one of Sr. AO member:**

**Deliberations:** AICAOA took the matter seriously and it was decided unanimously that a team of AICAOA headed by President, AICAOA will meet the concerned Pr. CCA and will raise the issue strongly to to initiate appropriate action. Further, it was also decided that if no satisfactory steps are taken, AICAOA will escalate the matter to O/o CGA, Secretary (Rev.) and Secretary (Finance). AICAOA will take all necessary steps to restore a safe, respectful and professional working environment for all Sr. AOs.

**Agenda 3: Status of Court Cases:**

**Agenda 4: Review of National Executive Committee, AICAOA:**

- (i) It was informed to all present members that Shri Ajay Sood, Asstt. Secretary General has tendered his resignation due to his acute personal engagements. Shri Ajay Sood who was present in the meeting stressed upon that he may be relieved off his responsibilities due to his personal reasons. NEC, AICAOA requested to continue till next GBM but Sh. Sood shown his inability for the same. Resignation of Sh. Sood, ASG was accepted by NEC underlining his pivotal role and special contributions.
- (ii) To balance regional representation in NEC, proposal of inclusion of NEC member from West Zone-I was mooted during the meeting and Sh. Amol V Sule, Sr. AO, Finance, Mumbai was co-opted unanimously as Asstt. Secretary General upto next GBM of AICAOA. All NEC members extended a warm and enthusiastic welcome to Sh. Sule, ASG.

**Agenda 5: Review of AICAOA Membership, Subscription and Zonal Committees:** Deliberations and decisions are as below:

- a) **AICAOA Membership:** It was informed to all present that AICAOA is enjoying almost 600+ membership but almost 150 members are not subscribing. It was also informed that many of the newly promoted Sr. AOs have still not joined AICAOA. It was decided unanimously that all Sr. AOs who are not AICAOA member will be pursued to join AICAOA to strengthen the common cause.
- b) **Formation of Zonal Committees:**
  - (i) Shri Debraj Singha Roy, Asstt. Secretary General was entrusted with the work of formation of East Zone and North East. Shri Roy accepted the task warmly and promised that he will try his level best to get it formed by May' 2026.
  - (ii) Shri Amol V Sule, Asstt. Secretary General was entrusted with the work of formation of West Zone-I. Shri Sule assured to complete the task by May' 2026.
