**MINUTES OF NEC MEETING**

An online meeting of the National Executive Committee of AICAOA held on 12<sup>th</sup> May' 2026 at 8:00 PM on Google Meet to discuss following Agenda Points:

**Agenda 1: Apprise all NEC Members of the discussions held with the Secretary (Expenditure), Ministry of Finance during meeting on 08.05.2026.**

**Deliberations:** All present members were apprised that the meeting with the Secretary (Expenditure), Ministry of Finance held in a very cordial and constructive atmosphere. The discussions were conducted on the basis of the agenda finalised by NEC, AICAOA, which mainly covered important issues such as the prolonged stagnation of Sr. AOs at Level-10 for 14-15 years, treatment of AAOs as Direct Entry, implementation of the judgment in the matter of PAO to Sr. AO promotion and other related concerns.

Further, Secretary (Expenditure), Ministry of Finance stressed upon that wherever there is any difference in understanding between the Department and the Association, both sides should sit together and deliberate upon the matter in detail for a better resolution of issues.

All the present NEC Members unanimously appreciated the development as a significant opportunity and conveyed their appreciation to the delegation for its sincere efforts.

It was unanimously decided that AICAOA shall submit a letter to the Secretary (Expenditure), Ministry of Finance seeking an early appointment with his staff, as discussed during the meeting held on 08.05.2026, so that the issues concerning the Sr. AOs of CCAS could be addressed expeditiously.

**Agenda 2: Inputs/comments on the proposed amendments in Recruitment Rules of Sr. AOs.**

**Deliberations:** O/o CGA has sought comments from AICAOA on proposed amendments in Recruitment Rules of Sr. AOs vide letter no. E-20569/A-65/5/2026-Group B-CGA/745 dated 06.05.2026. ### **Agenda 3: Issuance of readiness list of Sr. AOs for IMT.**

**Deliberations:** Concern was raised during the meeting that O/o CGA has failed to upload readiness list of Sr. AOs while issuing list of transfer requests of Sr. AOs vide letter no. A-65061/15/2022/MF.CGA/HR.III/44 dated 23.04.2026 despite of the agreement arrived at in the meeting dated 30.04.2025, as communicated vide Para 5.2.5 of letter no. A-23011/1/2020-NGE-CGA/ /62 dated 03.06.2025, wherein it was categorically agreed that the readiness list of all likely transferee officers would be uploaded on the official website. During last IMT of Sr. AOs, a partial and incomplete readiness list was uploaded vide O/o CGA's letter no. K-18002/1/2025/Promotion/MF.CGA (A)/IIR- III/487 dated 11.11.2025 and concern was raised by AICAOA during meeting with CGA on 14.01.2026.

After due deliberations it was decided unanimously that AICAOA will write a letter to O/o CGA for issuance of complete readiness list of Sr. AOs for IMT.

### **Agenda 4: Resignation by Sh. Rajeev Chandra, Assistant Secretary General**

**Deliberations:** During the meeting, Sh. Rajeev Chandra tendered his resignation from the post of Assistant Secretary General consequent upon his promotion and joining as Assistant Controller of Accounts.
