MINUTES OF URGENT NEC MEETING

An urgent online meeting of the National Executive Committee of AICAOA held on 15th January' 2026 at 8 PM on Google Meet to apprise the deliberations held during the meeting with CGA on 14.01.2026 and to decide future course of action to be taken up by AICAOA which is as below:

Deliberations: At the outset, all the representatives of AICAOA who attended the meeting with CGA on 14.01.2026 informed all the present NEC members about the point-wise deliberations held during the meeting. NEC members were informed that while the meeting was commenced on a positive note and conducted in a cordial manner, however the same was gravely disrupted with sudden unruly, inappropriate conduct and discourteous behavior of Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA (HR) who was part of the official team accompanying the Controller General of Accounts during the meeting held under her chairpersonship with representatives of the Association. Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA addressed the representatives of the Association in a raised and aggressive tone, repeatedly interrupted them and attempted to browbeat and insisted the duly authorised representatives to apologize and withdraw a representation issued by the Association vide no. AICAOA/NEC/2025-26/198 dated 12.01.2026 (available on website of AICAOA i.e. <https://aicaoa.in>) regarding violations of the prescribed transfer guidelines. However, AICAOA representatives maintained restraint, dignity and decorum of the meeting despite provocation by Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA (HR).

All the present NEC Members condemned the discourteous and unruly conduct of Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA (HR) attempting to browbeat and insisting the duly authorised representatives of AICAOA to apologize and withdraw a representation. NEC Members stressed that such conduct was unheard in the entire history of Association and Union deliberations in the past. No such incident has ever occurred despite the existence of several disagreements on various issues. Such aggressive and hostile conduct is wholly unacceptable and has adversely affected the decorum of the meeting and impeded the orderly, free and constructive exchange of views for which the meeting had been convened. Further, following decisions were taken by majority:

Decisions:

- (1) NEC, AICAOA passed a resolution condemning the inappropriate behaviour of Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA (HR) and decided to send a resolution under the signatures of President, AICAOA alongwith "Note of Protest" to Competent Authorities and stake holders to ensure that such incidents do not recur in future.
- (2) As far as, letter regarding violation of transfer guidelines is concerned, it was deliberated again in NEC and was categorically affirmed that the said representation was issued after due deliberation and is based entirely on verifiable facts and documentary position and the NEC challenges the same be rebutted, if at all, only through facts and records and not through coercion or verbal intimidation.

- (3) Resolved further that any attempt to suppress or discredit a fact-based representation of a recognized Association by adopting an aggressive or hostile posture is wholly unacceptable, contrary to administrative propriety and undermines the established consultative mechanism between the administration and staff associations.
- (4) Resolved further that the NEC places on record its appreciation for the Association representatives who maintained restraint, dignity and decorum despite provocation and reaffirms that the AICAOA shall continue to raise genuine service-related issues strictly on merit and facts without fear or favour.
