While the meeting was commenced on a positive note and was being conducted in a cordial manner, however the same was gravely disrupted with sudden unruly and discourteous behavior of Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA (HR). Deeply disturbed by this conduct, the NEC (AICAOA) in its emergency meeting held on 15.01.2026 resolved to condemn the conduct of Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA and pass the following resolution by majority.

*The NEC of AICAOA resolve to condemn the discourteous and unruly conduct of Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA (HR) during its meeting with CGA on 14.01.2026 and register its protest. NEC further resolves that in the event of a similar incident in future, the NEC shall boycott such meetings.*

## **“ NOTE OF PROTEST ”**

### **Regarding Intemperate conduct of Shri Anang Rawat, ACGA during the Meeting held under the Chairpersonship of the CGA**

The National Executive Council (NEC) of the All India Civil Accounts Officers Association (AICAOA) places on record this Note of Protest in respect of the inappropriate conduct of Sh. Anang Rawat, ACGA, who was part of the official team accompanying the Controller General of Accounts (CGA), during the meeting held under her chairpersonship with representatives of the Association.

2. The NEC records that during the course of the meeting, Sh. Anang Rawat, ACGA addressed the representatives of the Association in a raised and aggressive tone, repeatedly interrupted and browbeat the duly authorised representatives by insisting to apologize and withdraw a representation issued by the Association regarding violations of the prescribed transfer guidelines. It is categorically affirmed that the said representation was issued after due deliberation and is based entirely on verifiable facts and documentary position and the NEC challenges the same be rebutted, if at all, only through facts and records and not through coercion or verbal intimidation.
3. Such aggressive and hostile conduct is wholly unacceptable and has adversely affected the decorum of the meeting and impeded the orderly, free and constructive exchange of views for which the meeting had been convened.
4. The NEC further places on record that the Association represents the collective voice of the Senior Accounts Officers (Sr. AOs) across the organisation. Accordingly, any conduct that seeks to intimidate or demean the Association’s representatives has institutional implications and cannot be construed as a mere interpersonal exchange limited to individuals present.
5. The NEC is of the considered view that the inappropriate conduct referred to above impinges upon the dignity and institutional respect of the cadre and is inconsistent with:
  - (a) Established conventions and protocols governing meetings chaired by senior authorities; and
  - (b) The norms of restraint, courtesy and propriety expected in official interactions with recognised Service Associations.
6. The NEC emphasizes that meetings chaired by the CGA are required to be conducted in an atmosphere of mutual respect, restraint and dignity and that any behaviour which tends to intimidate or silence one party runs contrary to the objective of consultative engagement.
7. The NEC further places on record its appreciation for the Association representatives who maintained restraint, dignity and decorum despite provocation and reaffirms that the Association shall continue to raise genuine service related issues strictly on merit and facts.
