Subject: 1. Extraordinary delay in the matter of Transfers and Postings of Senior Accounts Officers and Pay & Accounts Officers despite clear cut vacancies existing at various stations.

2. Violation and Non-implementation of Transfer Policy Guidelines in true spirit and protracted and intentional delay in issuing Transfer Orders on completion of Tenure or premature transfers on request keeping in view of the vacancies available at choice stations, and Rotational Transfers within the same station- Regarding.

Reference No. 1: CGA Office OMs dated: 23.01.2023, 26.12.2022, on seeking three options, first time, after implementation of Transfer Policy Guidelines in the year 2015-16.

Reference No. 2: Transfer Policy Guidelines, issued vide CGA's OM dated: 30.10.2015, and as amended/issued/clarified vide dated: 09.02.2016, 21.03.2016, 17.04.2017 and 19.04.2017.

Reference No. 3: CSB Boards Constituted vide 30.06.2022, 20.09.2022, 25.11.2022, 01.12.2022 and 15.12.2022 and cancellation of all these 5 CSBS.

Respected Sir,

1. This Association Letters and reminders: Your kind attention is invited to this Association's letters dated: 24th November, 2022, 15th December, 2022 and 3rd January 2023 (sent on your mail address too by this Association) on the above cited subject wherein it was requested to intervene, personally, in the subject matter cited above. Despite this Association's three letters requesting you for your intervention, since November, 2022, in the matter of protracted delay in transfers (for more than a year), it appears that there is no concrete action taken by CGA. However, the present status, once again, is brought to your kind notice.

2. Frequent change of Civil Service Boards by CGA- More than 5 CSBs in 7 Months time: Further your kind attention is invited to CGA's OMs dated: wherein the Civil Services Board constituted for the purpose of implementing Transfers and postings as per the transfer policy guidelines, have been cancelled again and again and forming a new CSB again and again thus resulting in undue delay in transfers of the PAOs and Sr.AOs and resulting in frustration, demoralisation, financial losses, health deterioration and so on among the PAOs and Sr.AO.

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3. Seeking three stations options from the Officers who have completed Tenure at Outstations for the first time after introduction of the Transfer Policy is meaningless and unjustified as felt by the Officers: In addition to the above frequent changes of CSB, now a new strategy has been adopted by CGA to find out more ways to make further delay in the matter, by issuing OMs dated: 23rd January, 2023 and 26th December 2022 (Copies enclosed) seeking three options from the officers who were posted and completed their tenure (3 years) at outstation for the first time in the history of CGA Office and especially after starting implementing the Transfer Policy Guidelines w.e.f 2015/2016 onwards.

4. Interchange of Officers who completed their tenure (3 years) at an outstation versus officers who have completed longest continuous stay at one station and has not served at an outstation, (Implementation of Para 3 (xx) by invoking the provision), if there is no vacancy at the choice station opted by the officer who has already completed tenure at an outstation: The office order issued by CGA Office, vide their OMs dated: 26.12.2022 and 23.-1.2023, for the first time, asking for submission of three options, as per Para 3 (xx), from the Officers who have completed their prescribed tenure at an outstation and threatening them that such officers who do not submit their options will be posted anywhere in India, as per Para 3 (i) of Transfer Policy, is not in true spirit of the transfer policy. This is not acceptable to any of the Officers posted outside. Instead of invoking the other provisions of para 3 (xx) wherein it was provided that in case there is no vacancy in the station opted, a person with longest continuous stay over and above the normal tenure of 3 years at that station and has not served at an outstation in the grade of AAO/PAO/Sr.AO, as applicable, will be transferred to accommodate the request of such officers. This is construed as a blackmailing tactic adopted by CGA Office threatening the Officers, who have completed their outstation tenure, that they will be posted anywhere in India, if three options are not submitted by the officers. This is against the true spirit of the Transfer Policy Guidelines framed for the purpose.

5. If the CGA Office does not invoke the proper rotation and outstation policy provision, as enumerated in para 3 (xx) then the officers posted outside will be moving outstations and those posted inside of their choice will be rotated at the same station forever. This will be against the true spirit of the Transfer Policy. The following are the highlights of the developments during the last 6 months regarding constitution of CSBs, Requesting of Options etc.,

1. The CGA office has failed to issue a single transfer order of Sr.AOs and PAOs till date and could not fill the vacancies arisen from January 2022 to December, 2022, as per the Transfer Policy Guidelines whereas Promotions, transfers and posting orders of ICAS officers have been ensured and issued, without fail, from time to time.
2. As para 3 (ii) of the Transfer Policy, Promotions and **Transfers and postings orders are supposed to be done on a quarterly basis.** (CGA's OM dated: 30.10.2015, 09.02.2016 and 21.03.2016) but the same is being not followed by CGA Office.
3. As per para 2 of the Transfer Policy, the constitution of the CSB should be placed in the public domain, but the details of the present CSB details are not provided and available in the CGA's website. As such, there is no transparency in placing the CSB constitution orders in the public domain.

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4. Guidelines were not arranged subject wise viz. Transfers on Promotion, Transfers on Completion of tenure at Outstation, Pre-mature Transfers, on request, before completion of tenure, Rotational Transfer Policy within the same station and Rotational Transfer Policy for posting at outstations, Postings on repatriation from Deputation, Definition of Tenures, notification of the anticipated vacancies for the purpose of Outstation Transfers, for the purpose of posting on Promotion at outstations, and so on.
5. As per para 3 (iii) of the transfer policy, the **likely anticipated vacancy position in the grade of PAO** will be drawn up and put in public domain by **1st March each year**. This is not done.
6. Options for choice of stations in the prescribed proforma will be required to be filled in by the officers and submitted not later than 30 days from the notification of the vacancy position in public domain. This provision has not been followed by the CGA Office. No prescribed proforma was attached to the Transfer Policy Guidelines OMs stated above.
7. In fact, three options should be sought from the individuals, especially on promotion either from AAO to PAO or from LDC/ACCTT/SR.ACCTT to AAO.
8. Further, three or even lesser options may be sought from the officers, if the transfer request is made by the officers before the completion of the tenure based on the vacancies available at that particular station. It should not be made mandatory but the choice should be given to the individual officers. If there are no vacancies, then only they can give three options, if they desire to do so. Other wise, they may be allowed to complete their tenure at outstation and on completion of tenure at outstation, invoke the other guidelines of the para 3 (xx) by transferring the senior person who have not done out station posting.
9. Deputationists upon repatriation are not being accommodated at choice stations despite clear cut vacancies at their choice stations. Seniors are ignored and juniors were given transfers to their choice station after repatriation from Deputation.
10. Representations, for transfers, based on Medical Grounds were not given preferences and not followed.

In view of the above, this Association once again requests your immediate personal intervention in the matter of Transfers of PAOs and Sr.AOs



2. 


Sub : Guidelines for posting and transfer of Gr.B (Gazetted) officers of Central Civil Accounts Service.

The policy for effecting transfers and posting of Gr.B (Gazetted) officers of Central Civil Accounts Service are formulated in conformity with DoP&T instructions, implementation of Supreme Court's Judgement dated 31.10.2013 in WP (Civil) No.82/2011 in the matter of T.S.R.Subramaniam & others Vs Union of India & others, and keeping in view special needs of the Service. The following orders are issued with immediate effect and is in supersession of all the previous instructions on the subject.

2. As per instructions of DoP&T vide their OM No.11013/10/2013-Estt.A dated 9.1.2014, all transfer/postings will henceforth be considered by a Committee of officers called as Civil Services Board(CSB) (Gr.B). The Committee would be recommendatory body, and the final decision will rest with approving authority. The approving authority in this case is the Controller General of Accounts. Separate orders will be issued and placed in the public domain regarding constitution of the Board.


3. Following are the salient features of the transfer policy in respect of Group 'B' officials:

- (i) All Gr.B (Gazetted) officers are liable to be posted anywhere in India as per the statutory rules applicable to them.
- (ii) The frequency of the meeting of CSB will depend upon necessity, and would usually be held once in a quarter.
- (iii) The likely anticipated vacancy position in the grade of AAO & PAO arising out of retirement, promotion, etc will be drawn up and put in public domain. This exercise would be done in the case of AAOs, immediately after the declaration of AAO(Civil) Examination results.



and in the case of PAOs, by 1st March each year. Options for choice of stations in the prescribed proforma will be required to be filled in by the officers and submitted not later than 30 days from the notification of the vacancy position in public domain.

- (iv) Options of officers must be supported with an Undertaking that they are also willing to be posted to stations other than their choice of stations, should their requests not be acceded to due to administrative exigencies, or non fulfilment of any conditions mentioned in the transfer policy.
- (v) The exercise of calling for options is intended to enable the competent authority to ensure that due diligence has been carried out to accommodate the choice of station of posting of officers. However, this cannot be claimed as a matter of right.
- (vi) Requirements of service and administrative convenience will remain the primary consideration that will determine place of posting of to a Ministry/Station. The choice of individual officers will be taken into consideration before a decision is taken.
- (vii) The approving authority is empowered to issue transfer/posting orders directly on a case to case basis under emergent conditions, where a meeting of the CSB cannot be convened at short notice for reasons to be recorded. This will however be exercised in exceptional circumstances, and not as a norm.
- (viii) In case any official comes under a cloud from the vigilance angle, or is subjected to a verifiable complaint, abuse of authority, misconduct or indulges in any other act unbecoming of a government servant, then he/she is liable to be transferred in public interest.
- (ix) Mere existence of a vacancy in a station does not entitle anyone serving in that station to be posted to that station, or an official serving outside that station to be posted to that choice of station. Filling up any




vacancy in any Ministry/Station will be the sole prerogative of the cadre controlling authority.

- (x) Normally on **rotational transfers**, the tenure in a Ministry/Station would be four years and the tenure of officers posted in CGA's office will be five years in the case of Administration Section, Examination Section, Gr.A Section, Gr.B and Vigilance section. In respect of other sections in O/O CGA the tenure will be seven years. The service period as AAO & PAO/Sr.AO in O/O CGA will be computed together for reckoning five and seven years respectively, if the officer is retained on his promotion as PAO.
- (xi) On completion of tenure in a Ministry/Station officers are liable for transfer either within the same station or outside depending on feasibility of swapping positions amongst serving officers subject to administrative convenience.
- (xii) Tenure of posting outstation, on **promotional transfer** will be two years in case of North East, Andaman and Nicobar, Lakshadweep and Jammu & Kashmir and other stations it will be three years.
- (xiii) Cadre controlling authority is generally not in favour of permitting officials to refuse promotion as it results in undue delays in filling up vacancies. Such requests will be accepted in exceptional cases where the official is able to convince the Administration with self attested documentary proof that the request is not simply to evade an outstation posting. The debarred employee will not be allowed to proceed on deputation during the period of debarment and will be posted again to an outstation vacancy at the end of the debarment period.
- (xiv) All posting orders will indicate a schedule for relieving the officials subject to a maximum of 30 days within which the officer is to be relieved. The relieving order has to be mandatorily carried out prior to the last date indicated in the Order. On expiry of the 30-day period,


the official shall be deemed to have been relieved, Pay and allowances shall not be drawn beyond the 30-day period.

- (xv) Representations, if any, will be addressed directly to the approving authority (CGA) only. Any representation in respect of posting orders is to be received in this Office within 15 days of issue of such orders, as orders are placed in the public domain on day of issue, failing which the same will not be considered. Representations will be considered by the approving authority on a case to case basis and disposed off within 15 working days. Representations need to be suitably documented and justifications provided. (self attested copies of documents in support of what has been stated therein the representation)
- (xvi) Accountants/Senior Accountants, LDCs, Stenos, DEOs etc on promotion as an AAO, consequent to qualifying the AAO (Civil) Examination will be posted outside their existing place of posting. The officers retiring within two years would be adjusted in the same/choice station subject to the extent of availability of vacancies: save administrative exigencies. No AAO (Civil) Examination qualified official will be eligible for their first posting in O/O CGA, PFMS and INGAF.
- (xvii) On promotion as PAO, officers retiring within 6 months will be adjusted in the same post of AAO by temporarily upgrading the post of AAO which he/she occupies. However, it would be ensured by the cadre controlling authority that the overall sanctioned strength of PAO is not exceeded. On retirement of the individual, the post shall revert to AAO. In case the cadre controlling authority is not able to operate this proviso due to any administrative exigency, then the official will be offered promotion wherever the vacancy exists.
- (xviii) Rotational transfers (on completion of 4 years) as far as possible will be done in the case of AAOs in June and in the case of PAO/Sr.AOs



In the month of August each year, for which crucial date for determining the 4 year tenure will be 1st of April of each year.


- (xix) Request for transfers in deserving cases may be considered before completion of the prescribed tenure. Such transfers shall be considered as transfer at his/her own request.
- (xx) On completion of full tenure of posting on promotion as AAO and PAO an officer can exercise an option indicating 3 preferences of choice of stations duly prioritized for posting. In case there is no vacancy in the stations(s) opted, a person with longest continuous stay over and above the normal tenure of 4 years at that station and has not served at an outstation in the grade of AAO/PAO/Sr.AO as applicable, will be transferred to accommodate the request of such officers. Women, PH officers and officers retained on medical grounds (as detailed in xxii) and those due for superannuation within two years, are exempt from operation of this provision.
- (xxi) The guidelines of DoP&T regarding posting of husband and wife in the same station will be kept in view as far as possible in the larger public interest. However, after due consideration, the decision of the Competent Authority shall be final and binding.
- (xxii) (a) Posting of women officers (b) Posting of Physically Handicapped (PH) officers (c) posting of officers who suffer from Cancer, Renal Failure, Thalessemia, Parkinson's disease, Motor-neuron disease and any other ailment that affects the mental ability by more than 50% or any other life threatening diseases in respect of self, spouse and dependent children shall be given due consideration for posting in their existing serving station to the extent administratively feasible subject to availability of vacancies. However, if any of these officers feel that any posting offered to them causes hardship, then, they can seek debarment and the same shall be accepted.



(xxiii) If officers try to influence a transfer through means other than the proper channel, action will be taken as per clause 20 of the CCS (Conduct) Rules 1964. This rule envisages that "No Government servant shall bring any political or other outside influence to bear upon any superior authority to further his interests in respect of matter pertaining to his service under Government".

(xxiv) In case an officer posted in NE Region, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Jammu & Kashmir is willing to continue at that particular station, he may not be transferred out as a matter of routine unless a request of other officers for posting to that station is received or any issue arising from a vigilance angle.

(xxv) If under any circumstance, any posting/transfer has to be carried out which does not conform to any of the aforementioned provisions, then the consent of Secretary, Department of Expenditure shall be obtained on file and implemented.

Attention is invited to this office OM dated 30.10.2015. This office has so far been filling up the vacancies in the grade of PAO by promotion from amongst empanelled AAOs mostly at the end of each month. However, some have expressed concern over this and have requested for effecting promotion on quarterly basis so that displacement is minimised. The suggestion has been examined in this office and it is proposed to effect promotions to the grade of PAO on quarterly basis from the vacancy year 2016-17 onwards. Accordingly it is tentatively proposed that for the vacancies accruing in the first quarter, orders will be issued by last week of June, 2nd quarter by last week of September, 3rd quarter by 2nd week of December and for the last quarter by 1st week of March.

2. All concerned are requested to offer their considered views on the above proposal within 30 days from the date of issue of this OM. Thereafter, the comments received will be examined and final policy in this regard notified before the commencement of the panel for the vacancy year 2016-17.



Sub : Transfer /Posting policy of Gr.B (Gazetted) officers of Central Civil Accounts Service.

Attention is invited to this office OM dated 30.10.2015 on the subject cited above. The existing Para (xxii) shall be substituted with the following :

Para (xxii) Women officers shall be given due consideration for posting in their existing serving station to the extent administratively feasible subject to availability of vacancies. However, if any of these officers feel that any posting offered to them cause's hardship, then, they can seek debarment and the same shall be accepted.

Para (xxii[a]) In the light of instructions contained in DoP&T OM No.36035/3/2013-Estt (Res), No.42011/2/2014-Estt(Res) dated 6.6.2014, No.42011/3/2014-Estt(Res) dated 17.11.2014 and 5.1.2016, preference of posting at the time of transfer/promotion will be given to the persons with disability subject to the administrative constraints. The term "disabled" shall have the same definition as defined in the aforementioned OMs viz (i) blindness or low vision (ii) hearing impairment (iii) locomotor disability or Cerebral Palsy (iv) leprosy cured (v) mental retardation (vi) mental illness (vii) multiple disabilities (viii) Thalassaemia (ix) Haemophillia and (x) autism spectrum disorder. The term "Family" in so far as this provision is concerned shall include self, spouse and dependent children only.

This comes into force from the date of issue of this OM.



Sub : Transfer /Posting policy of Gr.B (Gazetted) officers of Central Civil Accounts Service.

Attention is invited to this office OM dated 30.10.2015. This office has so far been filling up the vacancies in the grade of PAO by promotion from amongst empanelled AAOs mostly at the end of each month. However, some have expressed concern over this and have requested for effecting promotion on quarterly basis so that displacement is minimised. The suggestion has been examined in this office and it is proposed to effect promotions to the grade of PAO on quarterly basis from the vacancy year 2016-17 onwards. Accordingly it is tentatively proposed that for the vacancies accruing in the first quarter, orders will be issued by last week of June, 2nd quarter by last week of September, 3rd quarter by 2nd week of December and for the last quarter by 1st week of March.

2. All concerned are requested to offer their considered views on the above proposal within 30 days from the date of issue of this OM. Thereafter, the comments received will be examined and final policy in this regard notified before the commencement of the panel for the vacancy year 2016-17.
