Chairman (LC), while proposing the meeting requested all the members to go through the draft writ

petition for the Cadre Review case which was placed before the members of LC in its whatsapp platform in

the evening of 22nd September 2023 (Friday).

During the meeting, detailed deliberations were made on the draft WP and various queries raised by the

members were clarified by the Chairman. One of the clarification was regarding granting of IR, which was

missing in the draft WP. It was clarified that IR doesn't form a part of the main WP in High Courts. There

will be a separate application seeking IR. Some typing mistakes were also highlighted by the members

which were noted for modifications in the WP. The draft Writ Petition was thereafter passed by the

Legal Committee with some minor corrections.

Before concluding the meeting, the Chairman raised concern over the continuous absence of certain

members from the meeting resulting in loss of the committee from their valued opinion and directed the

Member Secretary to prepare a list of members abstaining from last three meeting of the committee and

recommend to S.G to place it before NEC for replacement or other necessary action.
