Agenda 3: Formation of new Zonal Hqrs/ Committees and Review of NEC, AICAOA:

- a) **Formation of Zonal Committees:** Formation of new Zonal Committees: It was informed by Secretary General that formation of 12 Zones have been provisioned in By-Laws/ Constitution of AICAOA. 6 Zonal Committees have since been formed and are working as on date. However, rest 6 Zonal Committees are still needs to be formed and made operational. Further, it was also informed that sufficient number of members are available for forming Zonal Committees in these 3 Zones i.e. East Zone (Hqrs.-Kolkata), West Zone -II (Hqrs.- Mumbai) and North East Zone (Hqrs.- Shillong) and Secretary General is in talks with members of these Zones for early formation of Zonal Committees. After due deliberations, it was decided that NEC Members will visit these stations at earliest as per convenience of members of that particular Zone and complete the task of formation of these Zones on Priority.
