## **MINUTES OF NEC MEETING HELD ON 28th FEBRUARY, 2023**

A meeting of the “National Executive Committee” of AICAOA was held on 28th February, 2023 at 08:30 p.m. through Google Meet platform and following members attended the Meeting to discuss the Agenda Points:

## **Deliberations on Agenda No.1**

At the outset Shri H.C. Mathpal, the President briefed the proceedings of our case on Cadre Review (OA No. 192 of 2023) which has been disposed of on its hearing on 24th February, 2023. Shri Mathpal submitted that the hearing went on for around half an hour and that there were inconsistencies on the decisions and that the final judgement couldn't be transpired. However, he apprised the following points which he could figure out:

- Court can't intervene in the matter of putting a stay on the Cadre Review of ICAS.
- However, CCAS Cadre Review dated 12.04.2022 has been quashed.
- Sr.AO (HR-2) gave assurance that the status of Sr.AOs as Gr.'A' will be maintained.

Shri Mathpal concluded stating that we should wait for the final verdict of the case before any further deliberations. Shri Kaushal Mishra added that we have to go a long way in respect of Cadre Review and hence we have to handle it with patience.

## **Deliberations on Agenda No. 2**

Agenda No. 2 was regarding reinstating/reconstituting of the Legal Committee which was recommended for dissolution by its Chairman, Shri U.C. Joshi on 24th February, 2023 consequent upon tendering of resignation by Shri P.M. Vishwamitra from the membership of the Legal Committee expressing his dissatisfaction on the functioning of the Legal Committee. At the outset, Shri Mathpal clarified that a Committee which has been formed with the approval of NEC can be dissolved only with the approval of NEC and not by any single person even if it is the Chairman. The following was then put forth before the NEC members for voting:

- Whether NEC members are satisfied with the functioning of the Legal Committee
- Whether Legal Committee should be dissolved as proposed by the Chairman
- Whether Legal Committee should not be dissolved and will stand intact
- Whether the Chairman of the Legal Committee should be changed

On the above issues, majority of the members expressed their satisfaction on functioning of the Legal Committee and were in favour of keeping the Legal Committee intact. Majority also felt that Shri Joshi is the most appropriate person for leading the Legal Committee considering his expertise in legal matters and sincerity in pursuing with the advocate and promptness in attending court with full zeal. Shri Santosh Kumar expressed his willingness to be a part of the Legal Committee, since he is currently on deputation with PMLA dealing with legal matters only. All the members accepted the proposal with applaud. While discussing about the chairpersonship of the Legal Committee, Smt. Asha Pal

suggested the name of Shri Umesh Kumar Saxena as an eligible candidate. However, since majority of the members were in favour of Shri U.C. Joshi, it was decided that in case, Shri Joshi is unwilling then only NEC will look for another one. Shri Mathpal clarified that in any case, the Chairman should be selected from the members of the Legal Committee itself. During the deliberations, members also expressed that there should be a defined Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for the Legal Committee.

### **Deliberations on Agenda No. 3**


Agenda No. 3 was related to the resignation letter tendered by the Secretary General, Shri P.M. Vishwamitra on the ground of his ill health condition. Members were requested to express their views regarding accepting the resignation tendered by Shri Vishwamitra. Before deliberations started, Shri Mathpal clarified that the copy of the resignation letter endorsed to CGA by Shri Vishwamitra is improper and that the same will be intimated by NEC once it got approved by them.

Majority of the members expressed their concern about the health condition of Shri Vishwamitra and agreed to accept the resignation considering his ill health. Further, all the members unanimously expressed that the working of NEC should also be guided with a defined procedure ie SOP.

The meeting was concluded with the following resolutions with majority by voice vote:

1. Dissolution of Legal Committee is not accepted and stands intact with its original members and Chairman. Shri Santosh Kumar will be added as a member of the Legal Committee.
2. The resignation which was tendered by Shri P. M. Vishwamitra is accepted by majority votes. As stated by Shri Mathpal the post of Secretary General will be kept in abeyance and the Addl. Secretary General will look after the work of Secretary General with the support of all NEC members. On pursuation by Shri Kaushal Mishra about the time period of such abeyance, Shri Mathpal assured that the new Secretary General will be selected by the end of April, 2023 or, till SOP is finalised.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to all the members who attended the Meeting.
