MINUTES OF NEC MEETING

An online meeting of the "National Executive Committee" of AICAOA was held on 22nd May' 2025 at 8:30 PM on Google Meet. Agenda points and decisions of NEC are as follows :

Agenda 1: Status of Court Cases.

Deliberations/ Decisions of NEC: Status of all Court Cases were discussed in detail which is as below:

All the court cases were discussed and deliberated. It was informed to all present members that Case No. R.A. 152/2023 has since been disposed further judgement was discussed in detail. All the present members were unsatisfied and aggrieved by the judgement and it was decided unanimously the association will file Writ Petition in High Court of Delhi without wasting any time.

Agenda 2: Non-credit of Interest in Bank Account of AICAOA.

Deliberations/Decisions of NEC: It was informed to all members that Bank Branch of our Association's Account was transferred from Palam Branch to Safdarjung Airport Branch during October' 2023 for easy access of bank branch due to its location at a Central Place. By that time, interest has not been credited by the Bank. Matter was taken up with bank branch

on earlier occasions also but nothing happened. After due deliberations, Shri Rajeev Kumar, Finance Secretary was entrusted to get it done at the earliest. Further, Sh. Kaushal Mishra, Secretary General (in co-ordination with Sh. Rajeev Kumar, Finance Secretary) was authorised to sign all papers required to obtain PAN Card in the name of Association.

Agenda 3 : Status of Disbursement of Imprest.

Deliberations/Decisions of NEC: It was passed unanimously in earlier NEC Meeting and Imprest of Rs. 5000/- was sanctioned to Ms. Rekha Dahiya, Asstt, Secretary General to meet petty expenses. However. it was informed by Finance Secretary that the same could have not been released. Finance Secretary, AICAOA was reminded to comply the decisions of NEC at the earliest.

Agenda 4: Special verification of Membership under Rule 7(2) of CCS (RSA) Rules' 1993.

Deliberations/ Decisions of NEC: It was informed to all members that AICAOA has received a letter bearing no. 23003/1/2020-NGE-CGA/101 dated 07.05.2025 from O/o CGA wherein it has been informed that re-recognition process of AIAPAO (C), Sr. AOs other Association; has been closed vide their letter no. 23003/1/2020-NGE-CGA/98 dated 06.05.2025. As such, AICAOA being the only one recognised association in the 'distinct category' of Sr. AOs is required to command minimum 35% of working strength of Sr. AOs in place of minimum 15% at present as per Rule 5(d)(i) of CCS (RSA) Rules' 1993. Further, O/o CGA has requisitioned the estimated members and list of members of AICAOA under Rule 7 (2) of CCS (RSA) Rules' 1993 to carry out special verification of membership of the AICAOA.

The Matter was deliberated in detail which is as below:

1. AICAOA was recognised vide O/o CGA's letter no. 23003/1/2020-NGE-CGA/270 dated 29.08.2022 for a period of 5 years w.e.f. 29.08.2022 in terms of CCS (Recognition of Service Associations) Rules' 1993.
2. Further it is mentioned in above referred letter dated 29.08.2022 that "the verification of membership is required to be done again on expiry of the current five year term as per DoPT'S OM No. 3/12/94-JCA dated 10.03.1995".
3. Rule 7(2) of CCS(RSA) Rules' 1993 provides that "the Government may, at any time, order a special verification of membership if it is of the opinion after an enquiry, that the service association does not have the membership required under sub clause (i) of clause (d) of rule 5."

After a detailed deep discussions NEC finds that:

1. AICAOA is recognised w.e.f. 29.08.2022 under another association category of Sr. AOs with second highest membership with a command of more than 15% membership as provisioned in sub clause (i) of clause (d) of rule 5 of CCS (Recognition of Service Associations) Rules' 1993.
2. It is clearly mentioned in O/o CGA's letter dated 29.08.2022 (vide which recognition has been granted) that "the verification of membership is required to be done again on expiry of the current five year term as per DoPT'S OM No. 3/12/94-JCA dated 10.03.1995". Further, DoPT's OM No. 3/12/94-JCA dated 10.03.1995 provisions about check-off system of verification only and there is no provision of changing the 'Distinct Category' from another association having command of 15% membership to first association having command of 35% membership and forcing any verification thereof.

4. As far as provisions laid down in sub clause (i) of clause (d) of rule 5 of CCS (RSA) Rules' 1993 is concerned, it provides for verification of membership under the same category in which the association was recognised.

After due deliberations, NEC, AICAOA decided unanimously that :

- (a) AICAOA will co-operate O/o CGA in verification of membership under another category having command of 15% membership of the working strength of Sr. AOs as on 01.04.2025.
- (b) AICAOA will provide list of offices (Ministry-wise) and list of members to O/o CGA to carry out check-off system of verification under the 'Distinct Category' of Sr. AOs as another association/ second association having command of 15% membership.
