Agenda 2: Formation of a delegation to meet Jt. CGA (HR) in pursuance of action taken by O/o CGA on different points discussed during meeting dated 24.10.2024.

Deliberations/Decisions of NEC:

Deliberations/Decisions of NEC:

Agenda 4: Status of formation of Delhi Zonal Branches:

Deliberations/Decisions of NEC:

Constitution and Bye-Laws of AICAOA provisions formation of 4 Zones within Delhi keeping in view the sanctioned strength of Sr. AOs at Delhi. Approx. 615 posts are sanctioned in Delhi which is almost 50% of Total Sanctioned strength of Sr. AOs. Many interested members who volunteered to share the responsibilities in Delhi Zone as delhi delegates were shortlisted during GBM on 14.11.2024. A meeting with these members have already been conducted by NEC.
